California Community College District List Of Proposition 1D Projects

August, 2007

The Board of Governors of the California Community Colleges has been very proactive in identifying projects that will be developed using Proposition 1D funds. Community College Districts submitted proposals in July 2005 and July 2006, months before Proposition 1D was passed by the voters so that proposals could be evaluated by board staff to determine which ones could be financed from Proposition 1D. Working with the Department of Finance, the Board staff successfully introduced the winning projects into the 2006-07 budget bill. Those projects became part of the 2006-07 state budget and in December 2006, one month after Proposition 1D passed, 52 projects began their project planning efforts with funds provided by Proposition 1D. Many of these projects are also using proceeds from local general obligation bonds.

The following projects have received Public Works Board approval of their preliminary plans and are now authorized to develop their construction design documents:
